Welcome to the 4th Session of the Phillip Dutton Eventing Academy! We are once again very excited to share our knowledge, world-class experience and home training facility with you to maximize your training experience with your horse!

The camp offers instruction from the Beginner Novice level through Advanced. Should you require an individualized conditioning program for your horse prior to camp, please visit us at www.phillipdutton.com for your Horse Fitness Questionnaire and Phillip will craft one for your horse.

Here's what you can look forward to from your camp experience with us:

- Individual and group sessions with Phillip
- Dressage and jump schooling with FEI-level riders
- Video analysis of your performance
- Cross-country schooling over diversified obstacles
- Work on show jumping techniques, including how to analyze and walk show jumping courses
- Daily seminars with leading veterinarians, horse and human fitness experts, and sessions with our international grooms
- Information on the latest equipment from leading companies in the horse industry
- Breakfast, lunch and some dinners, including our awards dinner
- A written analysis and take-home conditioning plan and photo!

What's Included?

Tuition for the camp is \$2,200. Opening date is February 1, 2010, and closing date is June 1, 2010. Fee includes:

- Stabling for one horse per rider, from Sunday afternoon until Friday afternoon.
- Bedding is straw. Initial bedding is provided and additional straw will be available for purchase.
- Each rider is allowed to have one person (groom, parent, or friend) to audit lessons and educational presentations. Additional people can audit for \$25/day or \$100/wk. These additional people can also purchase tickets for group meals.
- Breakfast, lunch, wine and cheese receptions and some dinners.
- Refunds: After June 1st, 50% of refund will be in cash and 50% will be refunded as a "credit" for future camps or clinics at Dutton Eventing Academy.

IMPORTANT RULES:

- Leave your dog at home.
- Bring your own hay, feed, water buckets, & stall cleaning equipment
- You must wear an ASTM/SEI approved or standard exceeding helmet with fastened harness at all times while mounted. Breeches, half-chaps, or boots are appropriate attire. Shirts should be neat and workmanlike.
- You must wear a safety vest while jumping cross-country
- You must wear a medical armband while jumping either cross-country or stadium
